



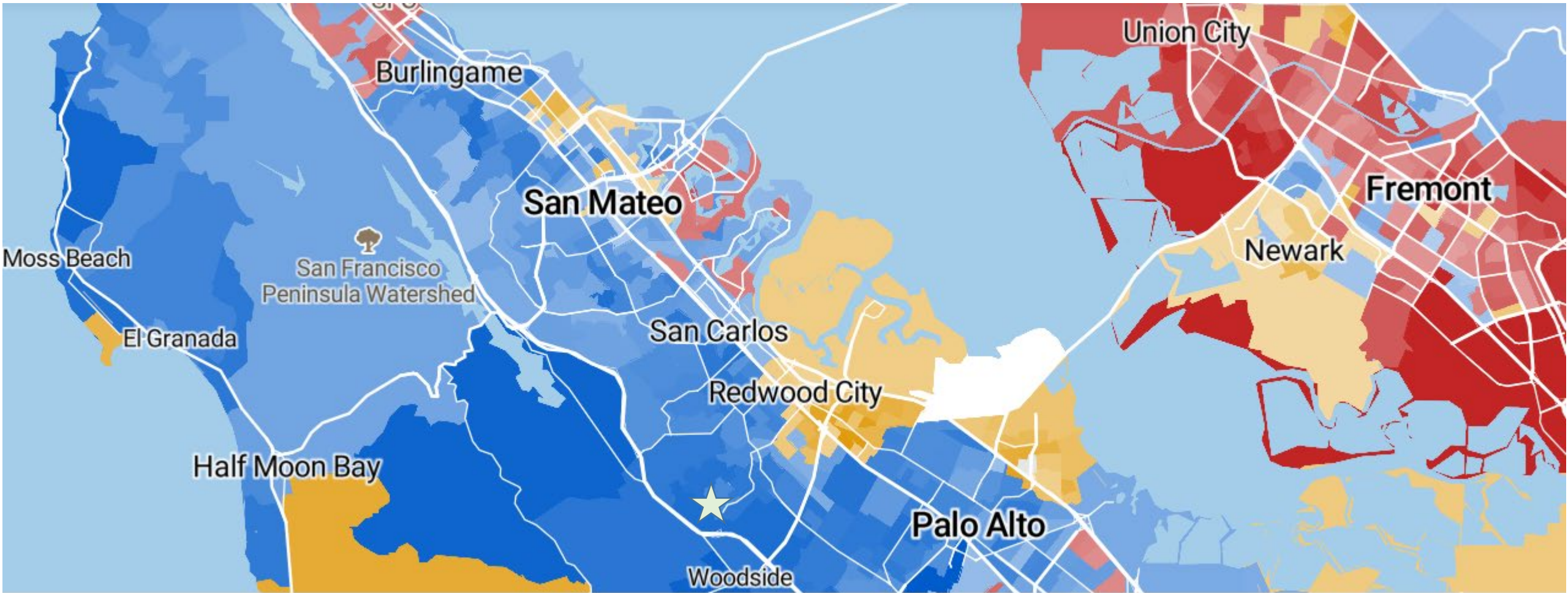

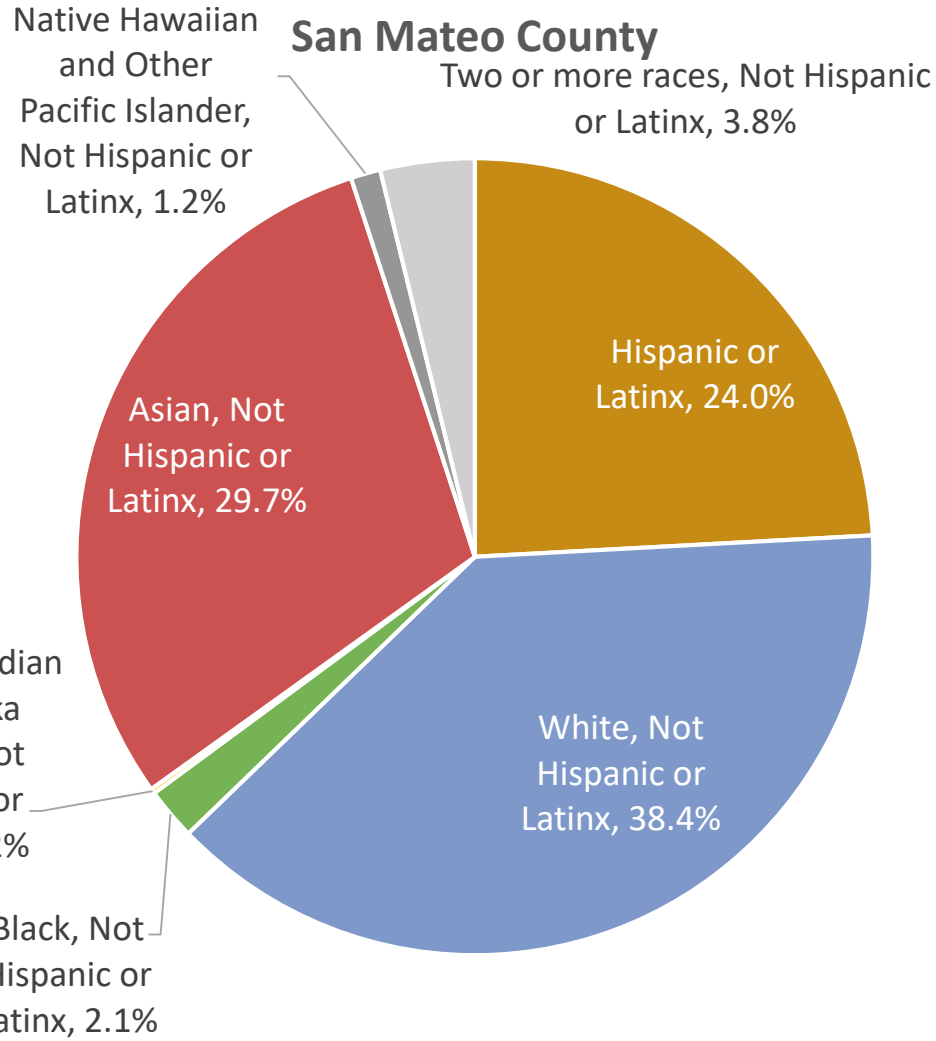

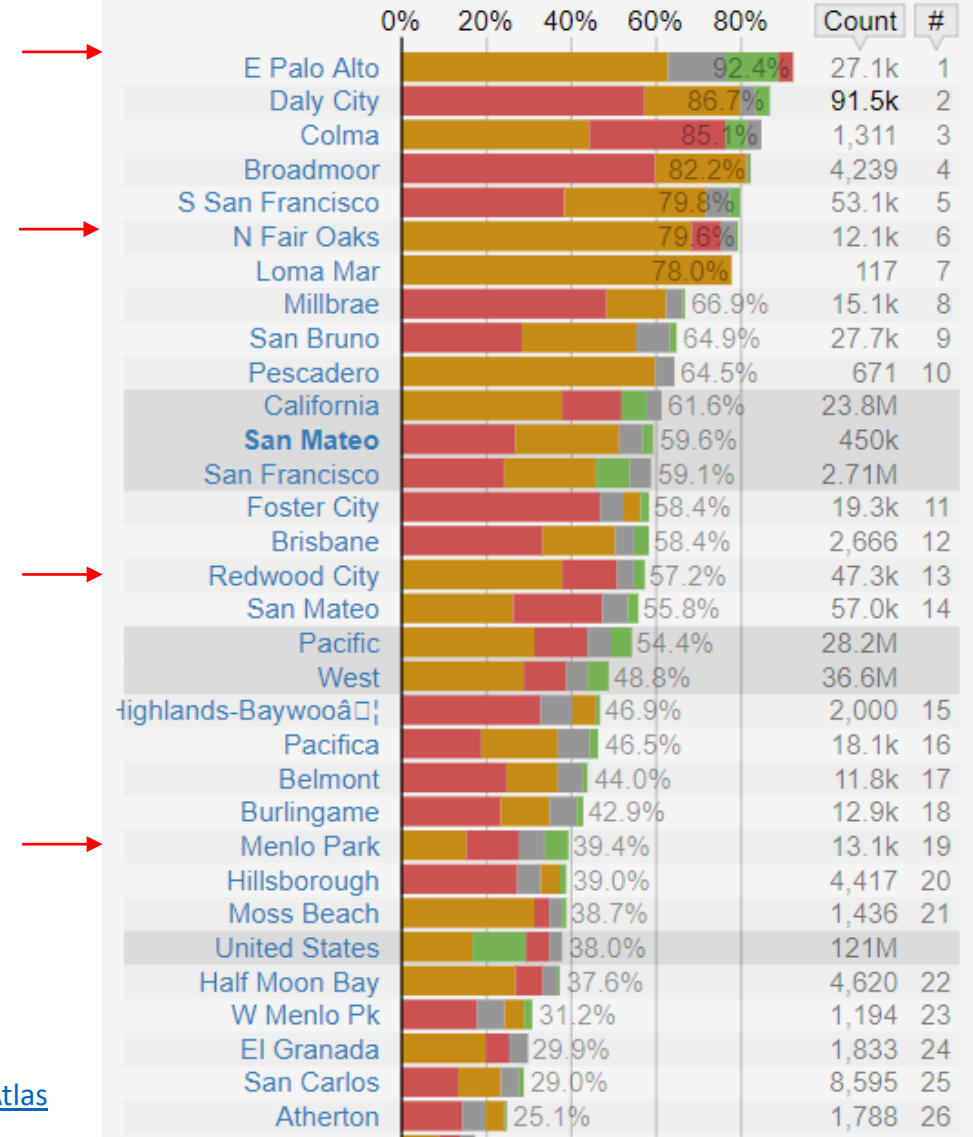

Non-White Population by Place

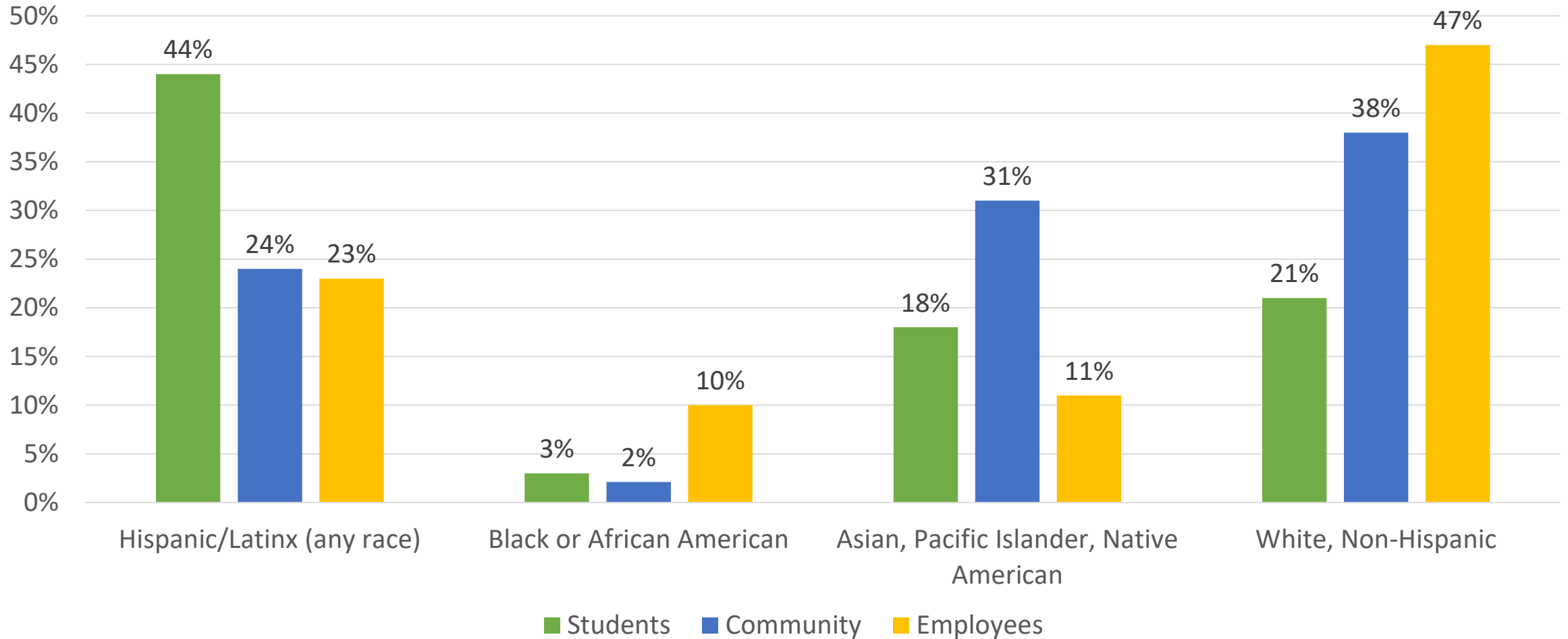

Scope: population of San Mateo County, selected places in San Mateo County, and entities that contain San Mateo County



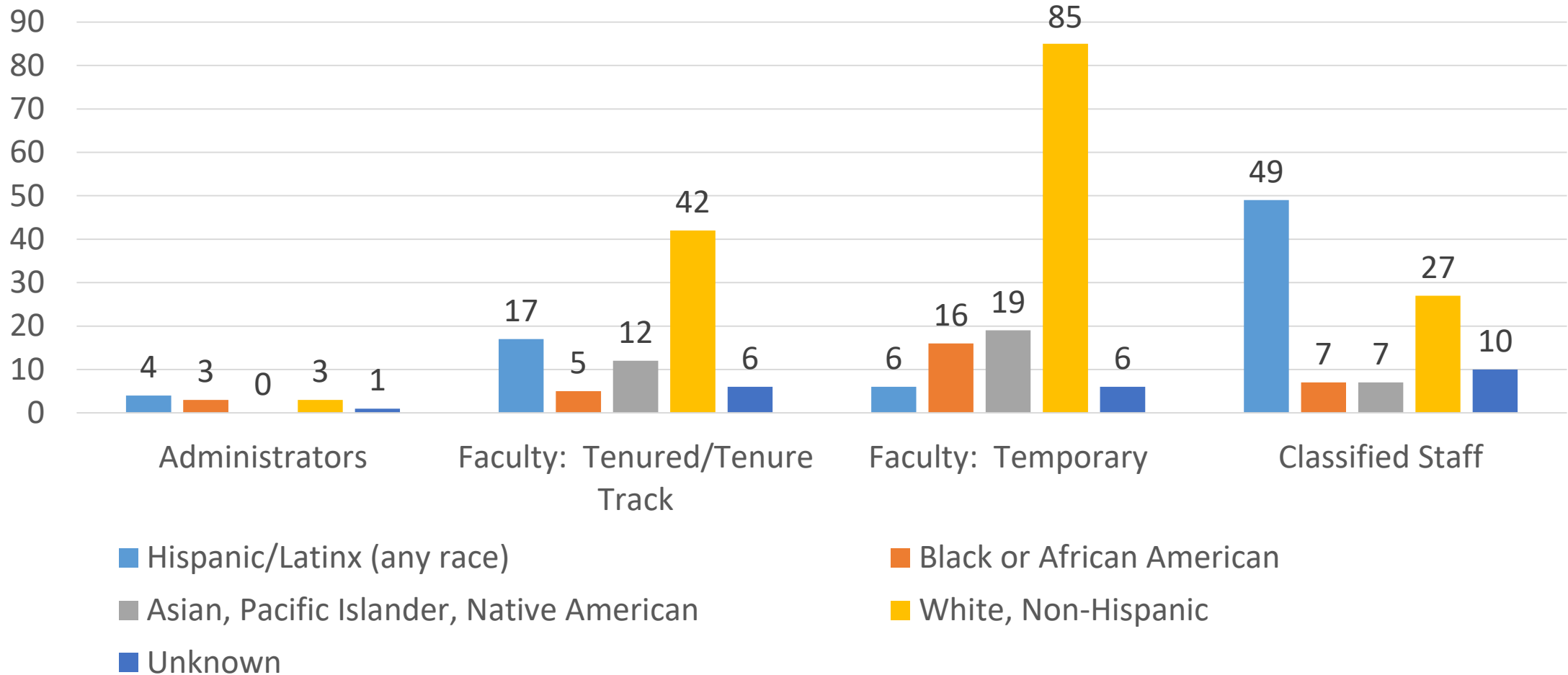
