## I. Study Abroad Update (Jessica Marshal)

- Study abroad is being offered in Florence, Italy for 2019
- Talked a little bit about how the program works, the housing (students will be placed in different apartments throughout the city)
- 4 Districts participate, Los Rios, SMCCD, Contra Costa Community, Santa Rosa
- 90-120 students usually go, about 25 students will go from our district
- Course transcripts have to be requested from individual districts

#### II. Business Department Update (Candice Nance)

- Leonor has been made permanent Dean of Business, Design and Workforce
- Seeking a replacement accounting professor to start in the spring.
- Accounting and business struggles because Professors can go out and get higher paying jobs out in the industry
- CBOT is trying to get some coordination time for somebody to just dedicate time on
- Partnership with Facebook is in the works
- Introduced Emilio Roque who is an adjunct faculty member who teaches Bus 158 which is equivalent to 150, can be used as a substitution
- In the Summer 2 sections of 100, 103 and 201 will be offered as online courses
- Working to figure out what other classes can be added during the Summer
- Business now is 1/3 in person and 2/3 online, program review has proven that from Fall 13' to Fall 18', enrollment has increased by 175%, this is due to online courses now being offered as well as a heavy summer load
- Nick asked about the accelerated program to which Candice responded that the model is being built of Skyline's model
- Noticing some different trends of patterns of retention depending on when the class starts
- Lorraine asked about the collaboration project with Facebook, which Candice responded that there was a publicly announced MOU and with Amazon Web Services (AWS), provide additional help with curriculum
