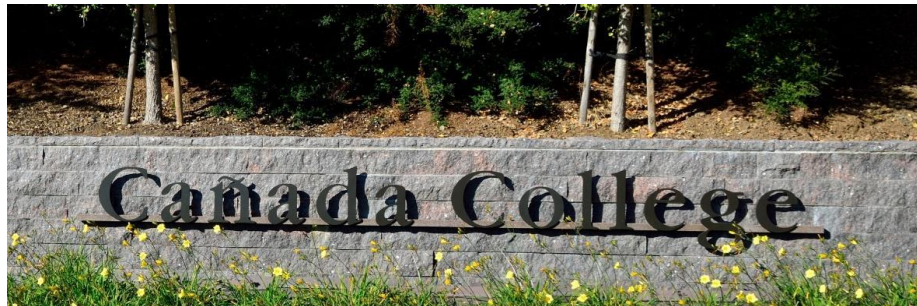

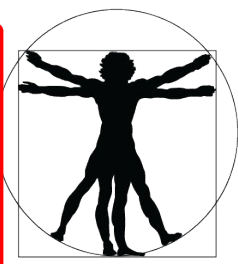

## UCLA Transfer Acceptance Rates

- Statewide: ~ 20-25%
- Statewide UCLA TAP certified ~ 70-75%
- Cañada UCLA TAP: generally even better! ... Up to 100% !

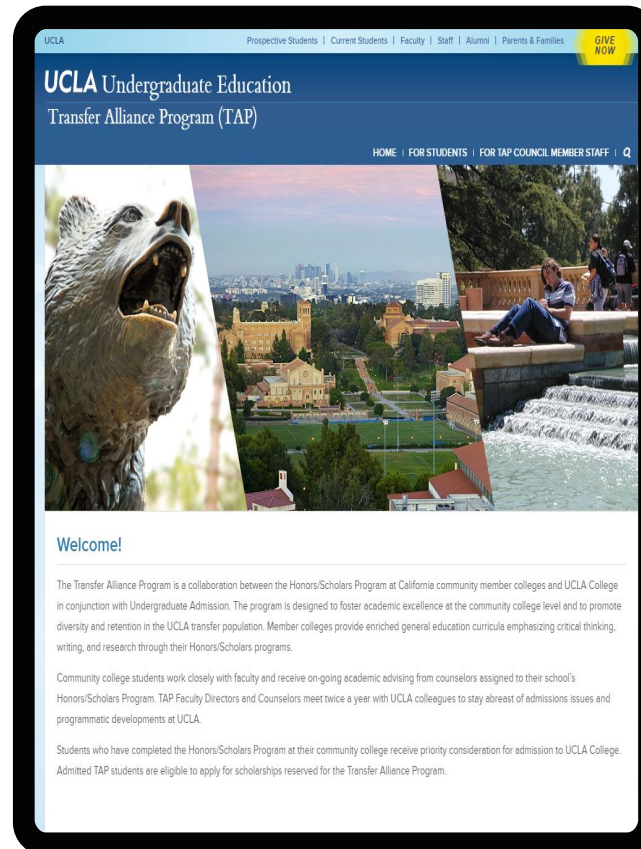


Eligible students are granted early admission to UCI (not necessarily to their first choice of major) and guaranteed admission to the prestigious Campuswide Honors Collegium. Students also receive priority consideration for a special set of merit-based scholarships.

#### How do I become eligible for Honors to Honors?

- Attain a UC transferable GPA of 3.7 or higher.

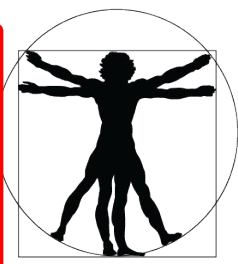

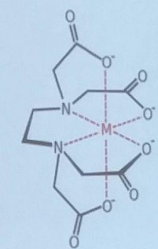
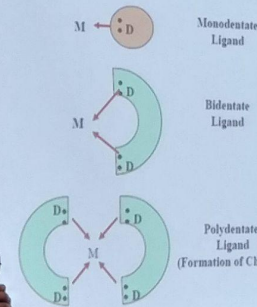

## Eligibility

1. Currently enrollment or completion of ENGL 100 or ENGL 105
2. High school GPA of 3.3 –or– college GPA of 3.3 in at least 9 units of transferable courses
3. Application

# Honors Counseling is Essential

- **To complete the HTP:** 15 Honors Units with C or better and 3.3. transfer GPA
- **Also:** some majors require lower division prep-work when you apply
- **And:** You may want an Honors course in your major completed prior to applying... so you can address the experience in your PIQs

## First Fall Semester

- Honors: ENGL 100 or ENGL 110 or MATH 200 (3 units)

## First Spring Semester

- ENGL 110 Honors (3 units) or another Honors Course
- LIB 100 Honors (1 unit)
- CRER 110 (1 unit). Take spring before you apply for transfer

## Second Fall Semester

- Honors Contract (3 units). Or another Honors Course
- IDST 150: Honors Research Seminar (1 unit)
- Complete your transfer applications. Apply for scholarships

## Second Spring Semester

- Honors Contract (3 units). Or another Honors Course
- IDST 150 (1 unit) (if not taken previously)
- Complete UCLA TAP paperwork (if applying to UCLA)
- Apply for scholarships
