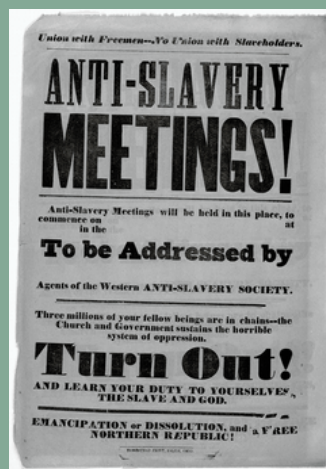

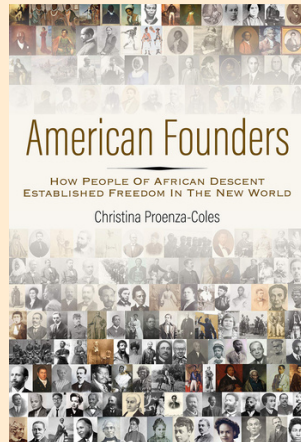


Black films, with links to where they are available to stream. In its current iteration, it showcases Black films made from 1915 to 1979 currently streaming. Created by Maya Cade.

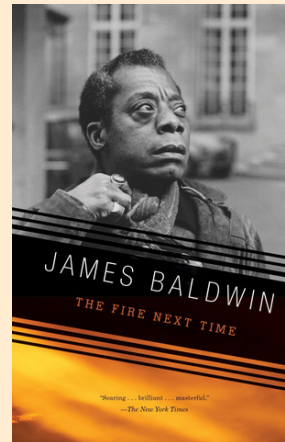

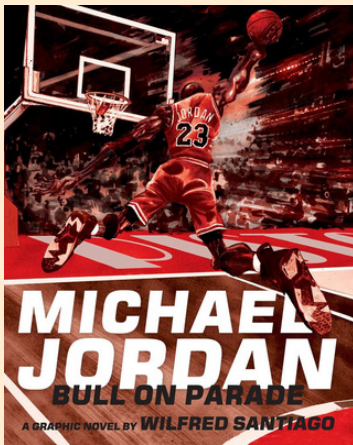

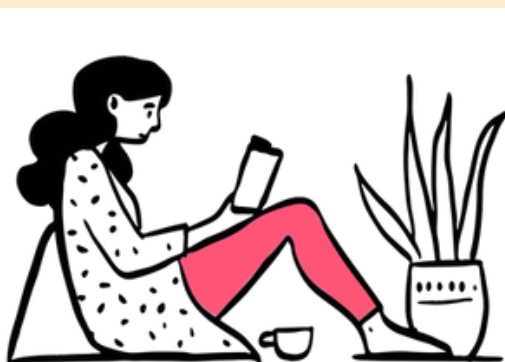

How to Check out Technology in 5 Easy Steps

**NEED A MOBILE HOTSPOT, GOOGLE CHROMEBOOK, OR
GRAPHING CALCULATOR FOR SPRING 2022? CAÑADA
COLLEGE LIBRARY CAN HELP!**

1. Come to the library circulation desk to request technology.
2. Present a valid photo ID (student ID, driver license, state ID, passport).
3. Your enrollment will be verified and you will be directed to complete an online Cañada College Library Technology Loan Agreement Form.
4. Technology items will be checked out to you for **3 months**.
5. At the end of the 3-month checkout period, **you are required to check in with library staff in person, call us at our main phone line at 650-306-3485, or email us at canlibrary@smccd.edu to renew your technology items.**

During this check in we will consult with you to make sure your equipment is still working, if other items are needed, and/or connect you to other student support services on campus.
