The Value of Safe Zone Allies on your Campus

- This workshop is to promote ideas on how to provide a safe environment on campus for the LGBTQ and undocumented students.
- Out of 100 LGBTQ and undocumented students, 35% of them feel unsafe in locker rooms.
- 55% never report assault or harassment to faculty or staff because they feel that they do not care.
- Pasadena City College is working to train students to become allies, create safe zones and to communicate effectively with the LGBTQ and undocumented students.
